NEW STUDENT FINANCIAL INFORMATION 2010-2011 SCHOOL YEAR

Application Fee - \$100 per student (**Non-refundable**)

Testing Fee - \$75 (**Non-refundable**) Grades K-12 if testing is required.

Please attach the application fee with the completed *Application for Admission*. **This fee is required for enrollment consideration.** The testing fee must be submitted at the time of testing if testing is required. The registration and enrollment fees must be paid within two weeks of acceptance and are required to secure enrollment for the 10/11 school year. All fees are non-refundable.

Discounts: There is a 4% discount for tuition paid in full (postmarked or hand delivered) by June 1st. For admissions after June 1st, please contact the finance office. Families with more than one student enrolled at OCS will receive a multiple child discount. The discount for the second child is \$120/year, the third child is \$240/year, and the fourth child is \$360/year. There is an \$840/year per student discount for members of Orangewood Presbyterian Church. This discount will begin the next school year after membership is established.

Tuition and fees include:

It does not include:

- Field trips, class trips, retreats
- Individual student health insurance
- Homeroom activities or dances
- Advance Placement exams
- Individual student pictures
- Yearbook
- SAT/ACT college entrance testing
- Lab fees, graduation fees

Monthly Tuition – All families who do not pay the full year in advance are required to enroll in a tuition payment plan. Sign up forms will be provided upon enrollment.

Student Accident Insurance – Individual student accident insurance is available for purchase and is required for any student not covered by an existing health insurance plan. You may purchase insurance at www.K12StudentInsurance.com.

Financial Aid – You may apply for financial assistance. No scholarship requests will be considered without the submission of the completed application, including 2009 tax documentation. Due date--**April 15, 2010**. Late applications will not be considered.
